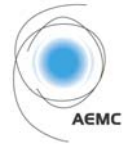


Notices under National Electricity Law



The Australian Energy Market Commission (AEMC) gives notice under the National Electricity Law (NEL) of the following matters.

Under Section 95, NEMMCO has requested the making of the proposed National Electricity Amendment (Integration of NEM Metrology Requirements) Rule 2007. The proposal seeks to amend the National Electricity Rules to integrate first tier metrology requirements and some jurisdictional requirements into the metrology framework. Submissions:

- must be received by **27 July 2007**;
- should be forwarded to submissions at submissions@aemc.gov.au; and
- will be published on the AEMC's website subject to a claim of confidentiality.

In relation to the "Statement of regulatory principles – revenue cap reopening" Rule change proposal, the AEMC has determined to discontinue the Rule making procedure and therefore under clauses 19 and 20 of Schedule 2 of the NEL, has re-exercised the power under section 94 and determined not to take further action. The proposal was originally submitted to NECA by Electranet on behalf of a number of transmission network service providers (including Electranet).
